Tasty examples could be a piece of fruit, a fruit bar, a yoghurt or a non-chocolate cereal bar.

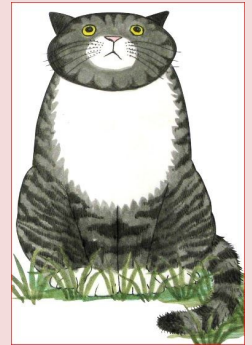
