Year 1 - Woburn Safari Park

As part of our 'Monkey Puzzle' topic this half term, we will be visiting Woburn Safari Park on **Friday 23rd February**.

This is a really exciting opportunity for the children to experience first-hand some of the African animals we have been and will be studying in class. In the morning we will tour the Safari Park on the coach, stopping to observe many of the animals. After lunch we will explore the rest of the park on foot. We will also have the opportunity to have a taught session each, led by one of the Safari Park staff and possibly watch some animal shows too.

School uniform will need to be worn and as part of the visit will take place outdoors children must also come with a waterproof coat and sensible shoes. Children will also need a packed lunch which you may provide from home or we can provide from school. Please indicate your preference below.

Children will need to arrive at school at 8:40am prompt, in order that they do not miss the coach. We will return to school in time for the usual 3:20pm pick up. If we are delayed due to traffic a text message will be sent so please ensure your contact numbers are up to date with the school office.

The cost of the trip is £14. This has been heavily subsidised by the school and fund raising by the year 1 team. Please complete the reply slip below and return with £14 by **Wednesday 7th February**.

We will require some parent helpers to assist us with groups of children. If you would like to help, please indicate this on the reply slip below. **We will let you know by Friday 9th February if you have been selected to support this trip.**

Medication which is administered within school, such as inhalers will be taken by staff. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please speak to the office before the visit to ensure that the correct forms are filled out and medication can be administered correctly.
